The California State University Risk Management Authority (CSURMA) has elected to join the EIA's Excess WC Program effective January 1, 2015. We are very excited to welcome CSURMA to the EIA membership. CSURMA is a JPA consisting of all of the CSU campuses and the affiliated auxiliary organizations. Because of its size and unique exposures, CSURMA will be participating within the EWC program with their own dedicated reinsurance placements. The EIA will also administer a reinsured aggregate stop loss layer on CSURMA's \$125K self-insured retention. We look forward to a long and fruitful relationship with the California State Universities.

California Trust Act (AB 4)

The California Trust Act (AB 4) took effect January 1, 2014, and prohibits a detaining agency from holding that individual beyond the point they become eligible for release from custody unless certain conditions are met, including that the individual has been convicted of specified crimes.
